Star Party Information and Rules

Location: Sun Lakes Environmental Learning Center-North of Ephrata (509-632-9977).

Accommodations: **Bunkhouses:** There are eight 10 person “shared” bunkhouses. (w/ Bunkbeds) **Reserved bunkhouses cannot be guaranteed due to the number of attendees.** See Accommodations Director. All bunkhouses are heated and air-conditioned. Bathrooms with showers are just down the path. There is a large mess hall with cooking facilities.

Unfortunately, the site is not ADA compliant.

RV's: Due to the lack of space, RV parking is assigned & limited. Please designate the length of your RV on the sign up form. Sorry, no hookups. If the RV spots become full, you can be put on a waiting list in case of a cancellation. **No EV charging stations on site.**

Tents: There are **2 tent areas available for those wishing to stay in their tents.**

****Offsite Attendees:** Those staying outside of Delany...**1.** Pay the same fee as others staying at Delany. **2.** Sign up for a job. **3.** Before dark, their vehicle must be parked facing west beyond the top of the hill so the lights will not disturb those viewing. **4.** Only cars or trucks can be allowed in for parking...**No RV's due to the lack of parking spaces.**

Things to bring: Bedding, pillows, soap, towels, warm clothes, regular flashlight & red flashlight. There is no TV reception so you may wish to bring games & reading material.

Food: The OAS will provide **breakfasts, lunches, dinners,** as well as coffee, tea, and hot chocolate. **Thursday, Friday, Saturday are Potluck Dessert Nights!** Bring your specialty!

Check-In: After **1:00 pm** on the first day of the starparty. If you arrive before **1 pm**, please remain outside the gate. **Possible delays** may occur due to the previous group.

The Gate will appear to be locked but it is not. It has a sliding bar to open.

Please Check in with Jeff or Cliff when you arrive.

Please be in camp by sunset in order to keep lights off the scope field.

Check-Out: Sunday....**No Later than 10:00am .**

Camp Directors: **Accom. & Attend. - Jeff / Work Roster – Linda / Event - Cliff**

State facility rules: No alcohol, drugs, fireworks, or discharge of firearms allowed.

Pets: Not allowed in any buildings nor on the scope field at any time. Pets are not allowed to be “walked” on the grassy areas in front of the cafeteria to the scope field.

Any excrement must be picked up immediately. They also must be under full control at all times with a leash no longer than 8'. Thank you for your cooperation.

Valuables: WA. St. Parks / OAS are **not** responsible for lost or stolen items.

Smoking: **Not allowed in any buildings. NO smoking on or near the scope field.**

Generators: Please limit generator use to battery charging only.

Caution: Eastern Washington does have rattle snakes, scorpions, and ticks as well as occasional strong winds. Be prepared! Be safe!

Space is limited: All attendees & visitors **must be approved** by the OAS board in advance. Sorry, no guests allowed as the State charges us for **all** attendees.
